



CALL-OFF ADWARD OPTIONS

The Framework allows clients the option of:

Direct award without further competition, where all terms and conditions of the call-off project are within the terms and conditions of the framework **Mini-competition**, where terms and conditions of the call-off may vary or be modified from the framework or at the choice of the Client.

When calling off projects, clients can use any one of a range of standard forms of building contract including JCT/SBCC, NEC/NEC4, ACE, PPC, TPC, FAC1, or their own in-house agreement.

OR

Eligibility

SWPA is a not-for-profit organisation, governed by public law and a central purchasing body providing procurement services. Publicly funded organisations throughout the South West use SWPA frameworks to procure works, goods and services to construct, refurbish and maintain social housing, schools and public buildings. 
Cost of Accessing the Framework

Although the framework is free to access for our public sector clients, companies appointed to SWPA frameworks are required to pay a small percentage ('the levy') of the total value of every invoice submitted to clients and to submit quotations to clients that are inclusive of the levy. As a not-for-profit organisation, SWPA returns surplus levy income to our clients to support social value initiatives in the local communities they serve.

General Terms and Conditions

LHC uses the FAC-1 standard form of contract to manage our frameworks. The LHC pro forma, which should be read in conjunction with the FAC-1 in published form, details the terms and conditions that govern the operation of the framework, including the procedures to call off projects under the framework.
